8817 I. 1. (b..) The Provider failed to maintain a personnel record for each employee identified below that included:
b. a criminal history check, prior to an offer of employment, in accordance with state law. TWO STAFF FILES DOCUMENTED THAT THOSE STAFF HAD CRIMINAL RECORD HISTORIES. THE FIRST HAS TWO FELONY THEFT CONVICTIONS (BOTH RS: 14:67). THE FIRST CONVICTION WAS IN 1983 AND WAS CLASSIFIED AS A MISDEMEANOR. THE STAFF PERSON WAS SENTENCED TO SIX MONTHS IN JAIL WHICH WAS SUSPENDED. SHE WAS PLACED ON PROBATION FOR TWO YEARS, FROM 09/21/1983 TO 09/21/1985. HER SECOND CONVICTION WAS IN 1998. SHE WAS SENTENCED TO TWO YEARS OF HARD LABOR. THIS SENTENCE WAS SUSPENDED AND SHE WAS PLACED ON PROBATION FOR TWO YEARS, FROM 05/13/98 TO 05/13/2000. SHE WAS HIRED BY THE PROVIDER IN MAY 2004.

THE SECOND STAFF PERSON WAS CONVICTED OF POSSESSION WITH INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE (RS: 40:966) IN 1976. THE REPORT INDICATED THE DRUG WAS MARIJUANA. THE STAFF PERSON WAS SENTENCED TO ONE YEAR OF PROBATION AND WAS REQUIRED TO PAY A FINE OF \$100.00 DOLLARS.
